- 2) Answers to application questions which reflect the amount of hard work and determination shown throughout the past four years and how the student continues to grow from one year to the next.
- Promise and intent of student to pursue a college education or trade school with acceptance letter or proof of enrollment.
- 4) Evaluation of applicant's personal information sheet; include a copy of applicant's transcript and letter of recommendation submitted by a teacher, coach, or mentor. (Not a family member)
- 5) Qualified applicants can apply to both scholarship programs Selma Trex offers, but can only win one award.
